Purpose

To ensure that University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences Regional Centers Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)-accredited programs provide a professional, equitable, respectful, and civil environment that is psychologically safe and that is free from harassment.

Policy

The UAMS Regional Centers Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC) has adopted the following UAMS Administrative policies to address harassment:

- 1) UAMS Administrative Guide, Policy 3.1.10 Anti-Discrimination
- 2) UAMS Administrative Guide, Policy 3.1.48 Title IX, Sex Discrimination, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Sexual Misconduct, Sexual Violence, Stalking, Gender-Based Harassment and Retaliation

Incidents related to Graduate Medical Education (GME) that are covered under UAMS Administrative or Institutional Policies must be reported to the Regional Centers Designated Institutional Official (DIO).
